A note from Mr.. Hughes

Kindergarten pre-enrollment is on Thursday, February 1st at 5:30 p.m. Please bring your child's birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residency. A reminder that your child must be five years old on or before August 1st, 2024 to enroll in kindergarten. This is a great opportunity to meet our awesome kindergarten team and see the school. Please contact the school office if you have any questions.

A reminder that school starts at 8 a.m. Students are not allowed in the building until 7:40 a.m. Students eating breakfast at school should report directly to the cafeteria for breakfast. Car riders must be dropped off at the car rider door located behind the school off of Mt. Tabor Road by the ballfields. Students arriving after 8 a.m. are tardy and must be signed in at our Welcome Center (Door #1) by a parent/adult.

School attendance is very important. However, if your child is sick, please keep them at home until they are well. Don't forget to call the school if your child is going to be absent. Our attendance hotline number is (812) 542-7302. Some preventive actions that the Center of Disease Control recommends to prevent the spread of germs: try to avoid close contact with sick people, cover your nose or mouth with a tissue when you sneeze or cough, wash your hands often with soap and water, and avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth. 




Find out what is on your child's mind by asking questions.

 Help your child develop critical thinking skills by responding to his or her questions with questions.




The health office desperately needs pants, sizes 5T-10 (large)!



Información para entrenadores y voluntarios




