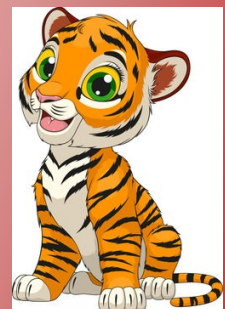

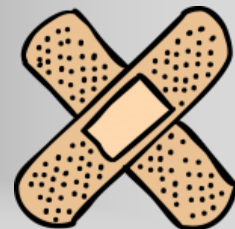
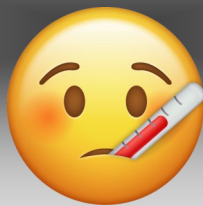
Attention Kindergarten Parents:
