



It's Cold and Flu season, still. Please keep your child home from school if they have a fever >100.4 or any vomiting or diarrhea and contact our attendance line to let them know. They can return when they are fever/vomit/diarrhea free for 24 hours without the use of medication.

This is also a common time of year for Head Lice. This time of year in late Winter our kids are bringing in their coats and hats to help with the cold chill outside. A lot of times students will share their hats with friends or leave their coats in a pile on the classroom floor. Encourage your student not to share hats, brushes, or coats in the school setting, along with sitting with their heads together. Remind your child to store their hats and coats in their backpack when they are not in use. Remember: Head lice don't jump, they don't live on pets and they have nothing to do with personal hygiene. No one is exempt from getting head lice. The most common way head lice is spread is by head-to-head contact. If you notice your child is scratching their scalp, you can check their scalp in a well lit area of the home or you can call and ask the school nurse or health aide to check your student at school. If you find that your student has lice, please contact the school and let them know. We have a supply of lice treatment from our health department that we can provide if assistance is needed. We can also guide you in how best to treat the home as well. Once they have been treated, an adult from the home will need to bring them into the health office for a head check. If no live lice are found, the student may return to school.
