

How can you nurture your child's interest in the past?


You and your child can learn about your family's history by creating a family tree.
Share what life was like when you were a child. Interview grandparents about what life was like when they were children.

 Create a scrapbook or photo album and fill it with old family pictures and mementos.
 Preserve tomorrow's memories by journaling or creating a time capsule of the present. Your grandchildren will thank you!

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The end of the school year is approaching fast. If your student has medication in the health office, please email or call us to let us know how you would like the medication to go home. If the student has a controlled medication, such as certain ADHD medications remaining (more than one pill), it will need to be picked up by an approved adult by 3pm on the last day of school.

If your student has a chronic medical condition that requires a Healthcare Action Plan, you will be receiving a Summer Letter with the new orders for next year. Please reach out to your child's doctor and have the necessary forms completed by the first day of school. All forms can be found on the district website, should you misplace your copy over the summer. Please remember to keep any students with fevers >100.4 home. They can return when they are 24 hours fever free without the use of medication like Tylenol or Ibuprofen.

This is also a common time of year for Head Lice. This time of year in late Winter our kids are bringing in their coats and hats to help with the cold chill outside. A lot of times students will share their hats with friends or leave their coats in a pile on the classroom floor. Encourage your student not to share hats, brushes, or coats in the school setting, along with sitting with their heads together. Remind your child to store their hats and coats in their backpack when they are not in use. Remember: Head lice don't jump, they don't live on pets and they have nothing to do with personal hygiene. No one is exempt from getting head lice. The most common way head lice is spread is by head-tohead contact. If you notice your child is scratching their scalp, you can check their scalp in a well lit area of the home or you can call and ask the school nurse or health aide to check your student at school. If you find that your student has lice, please contact the school and let them know. We have a supply of lice treatment from our health department that we can provide if assistance is needed. We can also guide you in how best to treat the home as well. Once they have been treated, an adult from the home will need to bring them into the health office for a head check. If no live lice are found, the student may return to school.

SUN BUCKS ARE HERE!

What are SUN Bucks?

SUN Bucks is the new version of the Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) or Summer EBT (S-EBT) program that the state has been participating in for the past several years.

DO YOU AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY?

• If your household already participates in SNAP, TANF, Income-Based Medicaid, Foster, Migrant, or Homeless, your child will be automatically enrolled in the SUN Bucks program. You do not need to fill out an application. You will receive a card in the mail that will already be loaded with the funds that are allotted to you.

IF YOU DO NOT AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY?

 If you are not automatically enrolled and believe your children are eligible, you can get SUN Bucks by filling out the Districts Meal Assistance Application that is located on the food service website. A link to the application is below or you may request a paper application from your child's school.

Application Info. Needed: child's name, school, date of birth, address.You will also be asked to report your household's income.
